The ultimate purpose is to serve as a transforming influence in the lives of program participants, providing the opportunity to learn, to grow and to move toward self-reliance.

PROGRAM FOCUS

Gateway Linens & Disposal Services facilitates the growth of participant core competencies through:

EMPLOYMENT RETRAINING

Enable program participants to be in a legitimate, functioning, positive work environment on a daily basis. Equip program participants for success by providing the opportunity to experience the level of effort, variety of job actions, supervisor-worker relationships, teamwork and interpersonal dynamics that are needed in any workplace and vocational setting.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

Provide a range of workplace-related training opportunities, certifications and licenses where applicable, including but not limited to: Health & Safety; WHMIS; Fire Safety; Emergency Preparedness; Violence and Workplace Harassment: Risks and Actions; MusculoSkeletal Disorders and Prevention; Forklift; Commercial Vehicle Operator Registration; and other skills-focused training. Assist program participants to achieve competency in computer literacy, interpersonal communication and respectful negotiation.

FINANCIAL LITERACY

Develop skills in budgeting, personal spending, debt reduction and management, income tax responsibility, leases and contracts, and other areas of financial competence.

SELF-RELIANCE

Equip program participants to live independently, increase self-confidence and initiative, and, ultimately, to flourish.
